Ivinson Memorial Hospital Introduces the 2007 New Year's Baby

Piper received a blanket, 1st baby of 2007 bibs, and a certificate explaining a \$1000 scholarship to the University of Wyoming from Ivinson Memorial Hospital.

This scholarship will give each New Year's Baby an early start on saving for college tuition. In order to use the scholarship, each New Year's Baby must enroll at the University of Wyoming by their 21st birthday or the scholarship will be forfeited and will be redesignated for the next New Year's Baby.

The scholarship program that Ivinson enrolled in with the UW Foundation Office requires a \$1000 deposit each year for 5 years. Ivinson plans to continue this tradition beyond the initial 5 year term.
